"Therefore go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit" (Matthew 28:19), commanded Jesus as his last will. This command has been carried out by his faithful disciples continuously.

At the end of 19th century in America, young students took the lead of a students' volunteer movement that allowed missionaries such as Henry Gerhard Appenzeller, Horace Grant Underwood, and Mary F. Scranton to travel to Korea. They helped built churches and 269 schools, including prestigious schools such as Yonsei University, Pai Chai University, and Ewha University. Their mission work has paved the way for Korean missionaries to this day. The seeds they sowed 132 years ago has helped Korea be a nation that sends many missionaries around the world, second only to America.

Huree University was established in 2002 as the Information and Communication Technology University in Mongolia as part of a missionary outreach. It has been 15 years since Huree University was founded. With the help of many Korean Methodist churches and missionaries' dedication, Huree University has become a prestigious private university, rated as one of top 10 universities in Mongolia according to the Mongolian Board of Audit and Inspection for Universities.

Despite the fact that any type of mission activity is prohibited, 80% of students become Christian before they graduate. As a result, Yonsei University awarded the Underwood Mission Prize in the field of group domination to Huree University.

Huree University's mission is to help young students in Mongolia and its neighboring countries to become capable science engineers and nurture a passion for Christ Jesus in hopes that they will become leaders in their own countries, and partner missionaries for the Kingdom of God.

If churches in Korea and America unite with Huree University and affiliate Korean universities, about 10,000 doctorate Christian scientists can be nurtured, further expanding the Christian faith in Mongolia.

Tuition for one year at Huree University is 1,000 dollars. However, more than 50% of students cannot afford tuition and they are not able to graduate. Furthermore, in Mongolia, the average cost for lunch for 1 dollar yet about half of the students cannot afford 1 dollar for lunch. If one church can raise 1,000 dollars for tuition and 200 dollars for lunch, one student will be able to continue their education for one year.

With this support, Korean churches in Mongolia and Huree University will be able to educate students, allowing them to attend a Korean or American university for a master's or doctorate degree in engineering and science.

With your care and prayers, one student can be nurtured to be a great scientist.

About President of Huree University of Information Communication Technology



President Chung Soon Hoon is a Methodist. He graduated from Pai Chai High School, founded by Henry Appenzeller in 1885. He earned a master's degree from Yonsei University and a doctorate degree from Yonsei University Law School. He served in Pai Chai University as a professor of Law for 20 years and as the president for 8 years.

While president of Pai Chai University, he published a book of the sermons Appenzeller preached, founded the Appenzeller Museum, founded a memorial church for Appenzeller, and built an Appenzeller memorial statue. He also built an education center for children and a statue of missionary Clara Howard in the yard of Pai Chai University.

In 2011, he left his position in Pai Chai University to pursue his missionary work in Mongolia. As a disciple of Henry Appenzeller, Horace G. Underwood and Clara Howard, President Chung Soon Hoon dutifully serves God and aims to spread the word of the Christian faith to those who need it most.

With the support of 1,000 churches from around the world, he hopes to cultivate up to 10,000 doctorate Christian scientists and 100,000 Christian IT specialists, along with 1,000,000 Christians through whom to build the Kingdom of God in Mongolia.

Mongolia is abundant in resources but science and technology are underdeveloped. The development of Mongolia requires the cultivation of excellent engineers. Huree University, the only private university entirely focused on science and technology, has been striving to nurture Mongolian scientists and engineers since 2002. The reality of Mongolia, however, is that there are many difficulties in producing excellent scientists because of the scarcity of teaching staff and inadequate research facilities.

Huree University specializes in teaching Korean and English language, and computer sciences in the first and second years. The university then sends students to Korea, the United States, Japan, or Germany as exchange students for one year. In their junior and senior years their curriculum focuses on mathematics, physics, chemistry, and biology. After graduation, the students may then go abroad to study for master's and doctoral degrees with the hope that they may return to lead scientific and technological development in Mongolia.

The dream of Huree University should never be abandoned; however, there is a persistent issue that calls for an urgent action. Many students at Huree University cannot afford meals and usually go without breakfast and lunch.

Our wish is that students have access to a hot lunch to help their young minds focus through the pressures of becoming science engineers, who not only contribute to developments in science and technology, but also help better the economy and living conditions of their neighbors in Mongolia.

With your generosity, we hope to raise enough for all students in need who attend Huree University. The cost of lunch per individual student is \$100 per semester. A donation of \$200 will feed a student and keep them healthy for a year. Together let us light the way for the bright futures of these students in the name of Jesus who fed a hungry crowd out of love. Thank you so much for your consideration.
